Hi Neighbors,

The City of Rolling Fields is working to bring back more tree-lined streets to beautify our neighborhood and restore our tree canopy. We've worked with a landscaper and arborist to develop a long-term plan to identify locations and tree species to best accomplish our goals.

To help reestablish a tree-lined street canopy, the city of Rolling Fields will plant a tree within 15' feet of the street in your front yard. All you have to do is place a provided marker and contribute a one-time payment of \$150. We will provide you with a small white flag so you can mark your selected location.

We will take care of the rest, including delivery, planting, and installing a deer rutting guard. You will be responsible for long term care, including watering if we have dry conditions (we have watering bags available if required).

Please choose one of the following species for your front yard; [Burr Oak](#), [Swamp White Oak](#), [Red Oak](#), [Willow Oak](#), [Bald Cypress](#), or [Tulip Poplar](#). Note that the trees are more mature and are approximately 15' in height.

Please submit your tree species selection and the desired street-side planting location by **October 31st** so the trees can be prepared for transplanting. The arborist has advised us to plant the trees in mid- February in order to give them the best chance to thrive.

Our annual budget allows for a limited number of trees, so this program is first come, first served. Please complete the included form and send to Fritz O'Connor at fritzoc@gmail.com before **October 31, 2023**.
